

Pass Brian's Bill – Bill S-281

PETITION TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED

We, the undersigned residents of Canada, draw the attention of the House of Commons to the following:

Whereas for over eight years, the Liberal government has put the privileges of criminals ahead of the rights of victims;

Whereas frequent parole hearings often revictimize and retraumatize the families of victims of murder;

Whereas the Liberal government has failed to respond to the *Bissonnette* decision, disregarding the impact that this decision will have on the families of victims of some of Canada's most heinous murderers;

Whereas Bill S-281, Brian's Bill, is a modest response to *Bissonnette* that puts victims first by preventing convicted murderers from applying for parole every year after serving their minimum sentence;

Therefore, we, the undersigned, urge Parliament to swiftly pass Brian's Bill.
